

CODE OF CONDUCT & PACKING LIST

YOUTH ADVENTURE CAMP

Are you ready for your adventure? Your camp is just around the corner! We want to make sure this is an adventure that your child will remember for a lifetime, so we have put together a few guidelines that our campers must follow whilst they participate in our exciting activities. Please take a moment to read through this with your camper so you both understand what is expected of your child upon arrival and throughout the camp experience.

1. Campers must treat other campers, Counsellors, and all Adventure Camp staff with RESPECT.
2. Campers must listen to and follow directions given to them by all Counsellors and staff. Counsellors and staff give directions to keep children at camp happy and safe. Undermining authority will not be tolerated.
3. Campers must keep hands, feet and other objects to oneself.
4. Campers shall not intentionally cause or attempt to cause physical or emotional harm to another camper or camp employee.
5. Campers shall not possess a weapon or object which might be considered a weapon, nor will any illegal substances brought to camp be tolerated.
6. Campers must never touch another camper's personal belongings. Campers must treat Adventure Camp equipment, supplies, and facilities properly and with care.
7. Campers must not take or touch anything belonging to a staff member or recreation department without prior permission.
8. Campers shall refrain from rude language and conduct.
9. Campers must follow all playground rules and guidelines.
10. Campers shall remain with their groups at all times while at camp. No water or bathroom runs should be taken without permission and supervision from a Counsellor or staff member.
11. NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONICS are to be out during the camp day unless given permission by a staff member.

- Medication - If the your camper requires any medicine (allergy meds, or other) please bring them in a separate baggie clearly marked with the child's name and dosage.
- Electronic Devices - Please refrain from bringing any expensive electronic devices such as tablets, phones, music players (or other). The use of these devices is prohibited during camp hours & the camper is responsible for their safe keeping. Recommended to leave these at home to eliminate the risk of damage or misplacing.
